

## Zoom protocol:

- 1) Feel free to keep your camera (but not microphone!) on. We hope this will lead to a more human and more engaging online meeting. If we will have bandwidth issues we might change this policy.
- 2) There will be a question period after each talk and during the coffee breaks. If you want to ask a question, raise your hand using the option in the Participant List on the bottom of the screen. When the chairman calls your name, unmute your microphone and ask the question. You can also send your question by chat to everyone during the talks. Do not forget to lower your hand after your question is answered.
